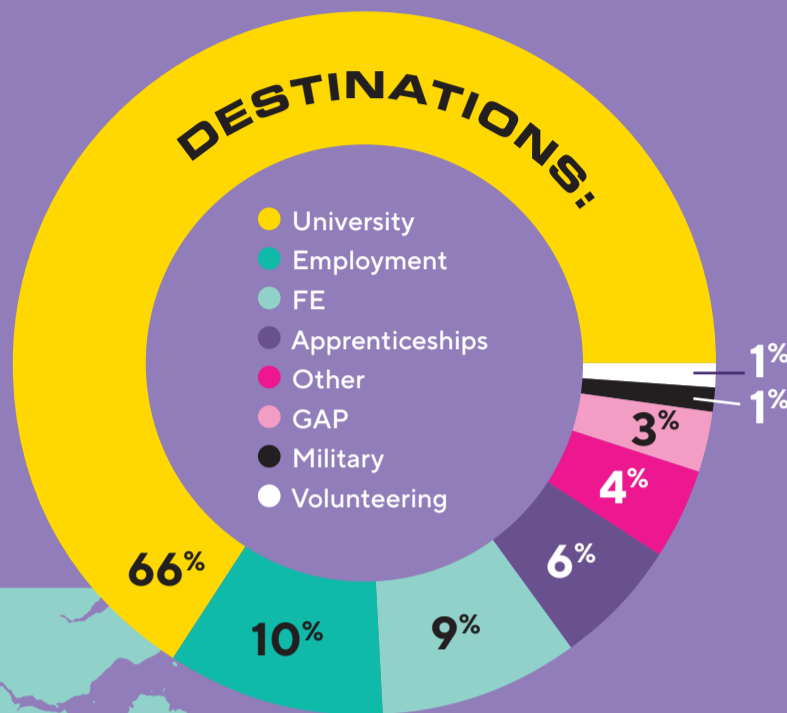

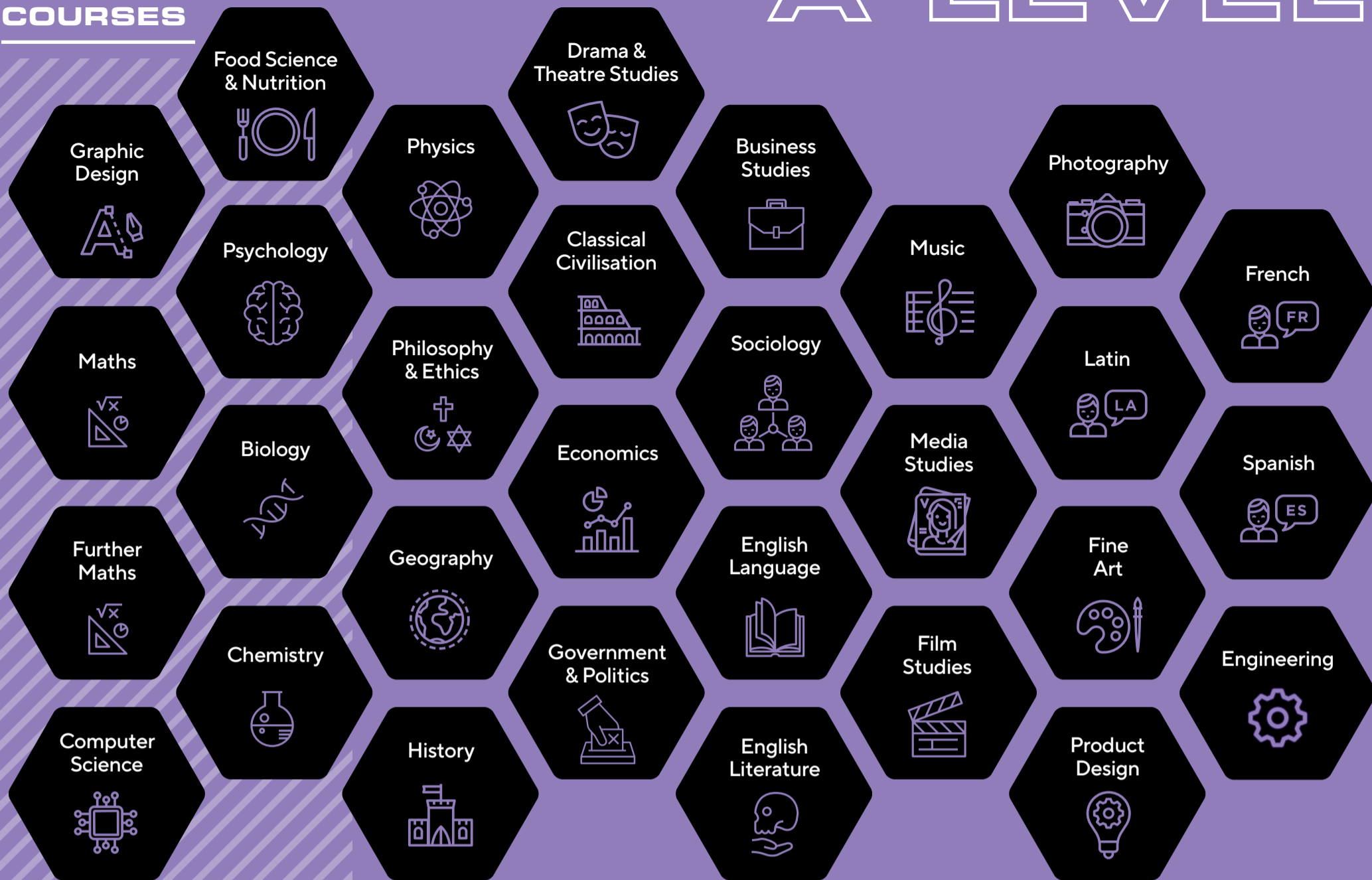

BURSARY FUNDING

There are two types of bursary available at Christ the King College worth up to £1200 per year to further enable students to access their education:

Vulnerable Bursary - For students living independently or with high level additional needs.

Discretionary Bursary - For students who come from low income households.
