Students will be formally assessed by exam style tests half termly along with essays and tasks formally marked using exam board criteria or sometimes peer or self assessed. In addition, students will sit a number of full mock exams to practise and develop exam skills.

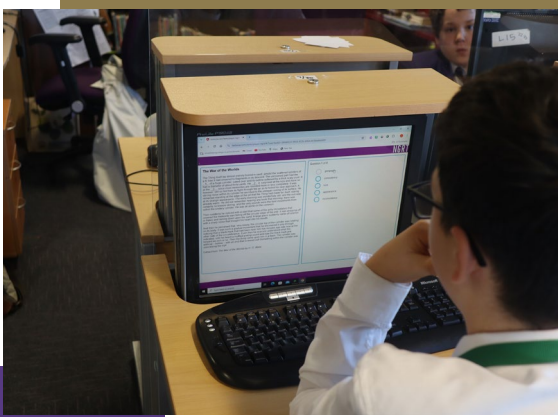
The final exams/ assessment

Three 2 hour exams at the end of year 13.

Independent Learning Expectations

Students should carry out 5 hours of independent study each week. This may include formal homework, posted on the Google Classroom. This will take a variety of formats from research, wider reading, planning etc. In addition students should be carrying out wider reading, studying the news, revision and past paper practise independently, without teacher guidance.

If a student is absent from a lesson, the materials should be found on Google Classroom; there is an expectation that the student will make efforts to catch up the missed work in their own time.
