## When and How Assessment of Learning will Happen

Whilst students will have the chance to practice past exam questions, there will be some mock assessments given throughout the year in which to prepare students and hopefully help them on their long term memory. Towards the end of Year 10 there is a mock exam on the content for the year.

We will conduct a variety of formative assessments throughout the academic year in which to assess student progress and pinpoint areas for development. This will be checking subject knowledge and the ability to write short essays on a variety of religious or ethical topics.
